In April, the Heirloom Companies took home the award for Best Staircase at the ninth annual [Bridge Awards Gala](#), marking the third consecutive year that the company has won the title. The Gala is hosted by the HBA of Greenville and recognizes outstanding craftsmanship and professionalism in the Home Building industry in the Upstate.

Finally, The Heirloom Companies secured two awards at the [2022 Staircraft Awards](#) – Best Commercial Stairway and Best Curved Stairway – hosted by the SMA in Memphis, Tennessee. According to the Association, “these awards recognize the individual achievements of our SMA members while elevating the industry standards of aesthetic value, stair safety, quality of workmanship and technical achievement.”
